collected will be donated to Northumberland Food Share Food Bank.



IMPORTANT MESSAGE: For all parishioners who are enrolled in their parishes Preauthorized Offertory Plan (POP), there was an error in the processing date for the September 15th POP withdrawal. *The POP was withdrawn from parishioner's bank accounts on Wednesday September 1st (should have been September 15th). The Diocese manages the processing of these monthly POP withdrawals with the bank and sincerely apologizes for this error. If the POP was rejected by a parishioner's bank, RBC the Diocesan bank, automatically retries to withdraw the funds again within a 7 – 10 day period. RBC does not charge a NSF/bank fee unless the second withdrawal transaction is rejected again. If parishioners are charged an NSF fee by their bank, due to this early withdrawal date error, the parish will reimburse the bank charge to the parishioner based on submission of bank charge cost to the parish office.
