***World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation 2022**

Author: Pope Francis *The cry of a collapsing planet We can hear the planet's "cries of anguish", Pope Francis said in his message for the celebration of World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, set to take place on 1 September. Mother earth, he said, "implores us to put an end to our abuses and to her destruction". The following is the English text of the Holy Father's message, which was presented on Thursday, 12 July [2022].*

Dear brothers and sisters! "Listen to the voice of creation" is the theme and invitation of this year's Season of Creation. The ecumenical phase begins on 1 September with the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and concludes on 4 October with the feast of Saint Francis. It is a special time for all Christians to pray and work together to care for our common home.
